- Approximately 125 well-paying jobs created during construction

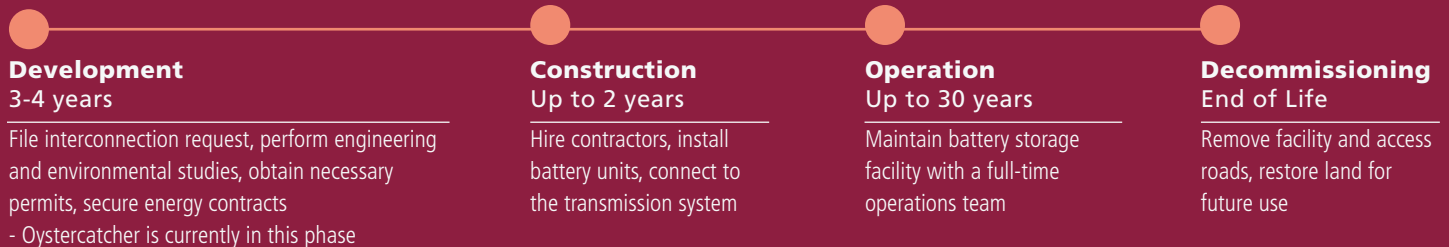
